STUDENT AGREEMENT FORM

PARENTS: Please share these TVCT rules with your child before they attend our programs. Sign and return the agreement. The family's participation in these efforts is crucial. We want your child to have a wonderful time while keeping our programs safe and enjoyable for everyone.

TVCT GROUND RULES

- Commit your time and talent to the program and your peers
- Respect yourself, your teachers, your peers and the space
- Demonstrate courage and make brave choices in class
- · Show enthusiasm for trying new things, meeting new people and exploring new ideas
- Strive for excellence in being the best version of yourself in everything that you do

SPECIFIC RULES

- I. Stay with your class in the assigned areas at all times.
- 2. Respect and obey all staff.
- 3. Take pride in TVCT and the equipment. Take good care of them.
- 4. Taunting, teasing, bullying, backstabbing, or other unsupportive and disrespectful acts will be dealt with immediately. Words can hurt, so watch yourself, and even if you don't like someone ACT like you do!
- 5. Keep your hands to yourself. Fighting, slapping, shoving, or other violent acts will be dealt with immediately!
- 6. Leave all toys and games at home for their safety. TVCT is not responsible for damaged, lost or stolen items.
- 7. Do not touch items belonging to others. Theft is a crime and will be handled as such.

DISCIPLINE

All students enrolled in TVCT programs will be expected to follow rules established by the Staff for the purpose of safety and educational outcomes. The following steps will handle all discipline actions:

- I. Verbal warning.
- 2. Questioning of the student followed by a reminder of rules and proper behavior.

3. Removal from activity for remainder of activity time period. Behavior notice will be recorded and given to the parents of the student.

4. If the child has a continual behavior problem, the parents will be asked to meet with the Educator and Education Director.

5. Children with repeat discipline challenges will be asked to leave the program. Tuition will not be refunded.

BEHAVIOR WARRANTING IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE PROGRAM:

- I. Fighting, physical intimidation or verbal threatening of another student or staff member.
- 2. The use of alcohol, cigarettes, and other illegal substances. Any student found using these substances will be released from class/camp immediately.
- 3. Theft, shoplifting or stealing of any form.
