Summer 2020 Safety Guidelines

Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, TVCT is taking additional measures to promote the safety of our families and staff. When registering for a summer camp with TVCT which meets at Boise Little Theater or the TVCT Studio in Meridian or at any other facility rented by TVCT, please agree to follow the following guidelines:

- If the child or anyone in the household is exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, has been in contact with a confirmed case, or recently traveled to a known hotspot for community spread, please stay home.
- Parents or guardians will take the child's temperature at home before camp begins and report the finding at drop-off.
- Parents/caregivers should remain in their car during drop-off and pick-up and a TVCT staff member will come out to your car.
- Parents will be asked the following CDC health screening questions before a child exits the vehicle:
 - 1. Has the child had any of the following symptoms of COVID-19 since the last time they were in care?
 - A cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Two or more of the following symptoms
 - A fever of 100.4°F or higher or a sense of having a fever
 - A sore throat
 - Chills or repeated shaking with chills
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Muscle aches
 - 2. Does anyone in your household have any of the above signs right now?
 - 3. Has your child been close with anyone suspected or confirmed with COVID-19?
 - 4. Has your child had any medication to reduce a fever before coming to care?
- Parents and visitors will not enter the building. A cell phone number will be provided if a student or staff member needs to be reached during camp hours.
- All students will wear a mask into the building and agree to wear their mask during times when social distancing practices are difficult. Masks may be removed during instructional activities at the teacher's discretion.
- During camp hours, students will participate in frequent hand washing and will practice social distancing.
- Students should bring their own water bottle, snacks, and supplies and will be asked not to share.
- If a child or someone in the home does develops the symptoms of COVID-19 or the child comes in contact with a confirmed case, please contact us immediately and stay home.

All surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized daily before and after camp sessions. All staff members will undergo frequent health safety checks and will wear masks when social distancing is difficult.

Should anyone develop symptoms while on site, a separate sick room has been set aside to isolate them until arrangements can be made for them to leave.
