Safety Guidelines Updated Summer 2022

Due to the ever changing nature of the pandemic, Treasure Valley Children's Theater (TVCT) is taking a tiered approach to promote the safety of our families and staff. By registering for a TVCT program which meets at our Meridian Acting Studio, Boise Little Theater or The Creative Space in Garden City, you agree to follow the following guidelines and understand there will be no refunds should safety guidelines shift levels after your program begins.



Level: Green

For programming where we are able to provide ample ventilation, social distancing, and when current community spread is considered low.

- Masks are optional during the program, we request your student bring a mask in case one is needed.
- Students are asked to not come to the program ill or if they suspect they have been exposed to any illness. Particularly, if the child or anyone in the household is exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, has been in contact with a confirmed case, or recently traveled to a known hotspot for community spread, please stay home.
- If a child or someone in the home does develop the symptoms of COVID-19 or the child comes in contact with a confirmed case, please contact us immediately and stay home.
- Please follow drop off instructions in the welcome email
- Parents and family may enter the building to use the restroom or at the initial drop off, but as always, TVCT programs are closed to observers.
- Performance will be held in person when space and safety considerations allow. Attendance may be limited. Recorded performances will be provided for programs not able to be held safely.

Level: Yellow

Should current community health recommendations/government guidelines recommend increased caution, there is an increase in the community spread of COVID-19, and/or other similar situations or for programming we are unable to provide adequate ventilation or social distancing.

- All students and staff will wear a mask into the building and agree to wear their mask during times when social distancing practices are difficult. Masks may be removed during instructional activities at the teacher's discretion.
- Parents or guardians will take the child's temperature at home before camp begins and report the finding at drop-off.
- Parents/caregivers should remain in their car during drop-off and pick-up and a TVCT staff member will come out to your car to conduct a health screening before a child exits the vehicle.
- Parents and visitors will not enter the building. A cell phone number will be provided if a student or staff member needs to be reached during camp hours.
- During program hours, students will participate in frequent hand washing and will practice social distancing.
- Students should not share personal items or supplies.
- All surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized daily before and after camp sessions.
- All staff members will undergo frequent health safety checks
- All performances will be recorded.

Level: Red

In the case of such events as an in-class COVID exposure, class size exceeds the most current community health recommendations/government guidelines on group size, there is significant community spread of COVID-19, and/or other similar situations.

- All programming will be converted to an online format
- All performances will be recorded.
